

La Hêtraie public housing estate.


The La Hêtraie housing estate with five buildings from 10 to 15 floors and 209 housing units is located on the edge of the town of Limeil-Brévannes. The entire site required overall refurbishment and requalification. The layout of the outdoor spaces creates several pedestrian crosswalks, punctuated by small squares and green spaces. The rainwater is drained off above ground in rain gardens and planted hollows. The new underground garbage containers free up garbage premises on the buildings groundfloors and allows the reconfiguration of the entrance halls and the installation of access ramps to the elevator landings. The refurbishment includes the stairwells and landings. All of the wet rooms are modernized in the 209 apartments. The interventions took place in an occupied site and in an asbestos environment. Different materials are recovered during deconstruction for reuse.









Requalification of the groundfloors



Requalification of outdoors spaces

#### La Hêtraie public housing estate

The public housing estate La Hêtraie, a set of five buildings of ten to fifteen flours, is located on the eastern municipal border of Limeil-Brévannes in Val-de-Marne. The entire site, open, is crossed by multiple users and requires overall refurbishment.

Our project for the requalification of outdoor spaces creates a centrality punctuated by squares and green spaces. Several pedestrian crossings intersect in this centrality. Rainwater is collected in rain gardens and valleys.

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
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Environmental Design

Rainwater is collected on the surface in a system of valleys and rain gardens. This promotes the development of biodiversity on the site and enhances the landscape for the inhabitants. The works on the outdoor spaces have also favored the on site reuse of certain materials in the planted spaces and the entrance halls.

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
